Sales and Property Taxes, December 2010 – Explanatory Notes

Property tax calculation: \$75,000 homestead exemption applied to parish tax calculation only, not municipal tax.

New Orleans: New Orleans and Orleans Parish are coterminous. “Fire and Police” 9.19-mill tax on first \$7,500 of assessed value.

Monroe: Monroe City Public Schools and Ouachita Parish Public Schools are separate systems.

Alexandria: The combined parish schools and “All Other Parish” millage is 92.580-mills; the breakdown shown is estimated.

Baton Rouge: City-Parish form of government. Included in Municipal Millage is a 6.00-mill property tax for fire pay and benefits.

Kenner: The \$75,000 homestead exemption IS applied to Kenner’s city property tax assessed value.

Lake Charles: Public schools in Calcasieu / Lake Charles have school-specific millages; shown is the average of those millages.
